



College Credit for High School Students Statement of Understanding

Great Plains Technology Center and participating colleges/universities offer college credit upon completion of selected technical courses. Parent/Guardian consent is required for a high school student to participate in this opportunity.

Eligibility: In order to be eligible for admission to the alliance college credit program and to receive college-level credit for GPTC courses, high school students must:

- have achieved a PLAN score of 15 or higher, an ACT score of 19 or higher, **or** an overall high school grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher.
- have a **Statement of Understanding** form signed by both the parent/guardian and the student.
- maintain at least a 2.0 average in their GPTC course to remain in good standing.

Transcripts: Guidelines and policies regarding the transcribing of college credit for high school students with regard to the cooperative alliance for technical courses taken at GPTC are as follows:

- **Once a student has enrolled in a GPTC course, the grade submitted at the end of the course will become part of the official college transcript which is a permanent record for the student.**
- It should be noted that the receiving college has the authority to determine the eligibility of those courses as applied toward the desired degree plan.
- Once a student is officially enrolled in a college course, **the student must complete the college/university's drop/withdrawal process for that course within the designated time frame in order for the grade not to show up on the official transcript.**

**This form must be signed and returned to Great Plains Technology Center *before* a student can enroll for college credit.
