

In all instances **notify your instructor immediately** and the **Student Office** at 580.250.5600 (Lawton) or 580.335.5525 (Frederick).
Lawton evening students should call 580.250.5500.

If you have ONE of these:

- Nausea/vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fever of 100.4 or above

Stay Home

You may return to school when:
You have been symptom free 48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

If you have ONE of these:

- NEW Cough
- Difficulty Breathing
- Shortness of Breath
- Loss of Taste or Smell

Stay Home

See your primary care provider to rule out COVID-19. You may return to school when:

You have a **NEGATIVE** COVID-19 test
AND symptoms have been gone for 48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication (You must remain home while awaiting results).

OR

You have a note from your primary care provider with an alternate diagnosis.

OR

If you have TWO of these:

- Headache
- Body Aches
- Chills
- Sore Throat
- Diarrhea
- Fever of 100.4 or above
- Congestion/ Runny Nose
- Nausea/vomiting

If you have had:

Close contact to a confirmed COVID-19 case (within 6 feet for a cumulative 15+ minutes over a 24-hour period).

Stay Home

For 10 days from the date of contact and monitor for symptoms. You **MAY** return on Day 8, if you can provide a negative test result within 48 hours of returning and you are symptom free.**

**If you have a
POSITIVE
COVID-19 Test:**

Stay Home

You may return to school when:
10 days have passed since symptoms started,
AND at least 48 hours no fever without the use of fever-reducing medication,
AND symptoms have improved

**The negative test is valid only when the test is performed on day 5 of quarantine or after. Test results must be provided to the student office before being released from quarantine and the student must be symptom free. PLEASE CALL THE STUDENT OFFICE FOR SPECIFIC INFORMATION.
