Great Plains Technology Center Superintendent Clarence Fortney submitted the application and Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students (Grants) under Section 18004(a)(1) of the ARP Plan.

Great Plains Technology Center was approved to receive \$905,991 under the ARP Plan, of which \$452,996 will be used as a minimum to provide Grants to students. Of the estimated 217 total students eligible to receive Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the ARP Plan, Great Plains Technology Center distributed:

• \$452,996 to 240 students as of June 30, 2022

For the Fall 2021 term, every full time adult student received a Grant in the amount of \$1,045. Full time adult students who were eligible for Pell received an additional \$100 Grant.

For the Spring 2022 term, every full time adult student received a Grant in the amount of \$1,170. Full time adult students who were eligible for Pell received an additional \$100 Grant.
